This professional development programme is designed to support early career teachers and those looking to strengthen their music teaching practice.

It provides the ideal opportunity to **build confidence**, **deepen subject knowledge** and **connect with others working in music education**.

Programme details:

- The programme begins with a full-day in-person training day at Saffron Walden County High School, focused on creating a positive learning environment, planning for progression, and developing key skills at KS3 to support success at KS4.
- Following the initial day, participants will take part in **three online twilight sessions** across the year (dates tbc), offering continued guidance on curriculum planning, inclusive teaching strategies, and assessment.
- The programme concludes with the **Greater Essex Music Curriculum Conference**.
