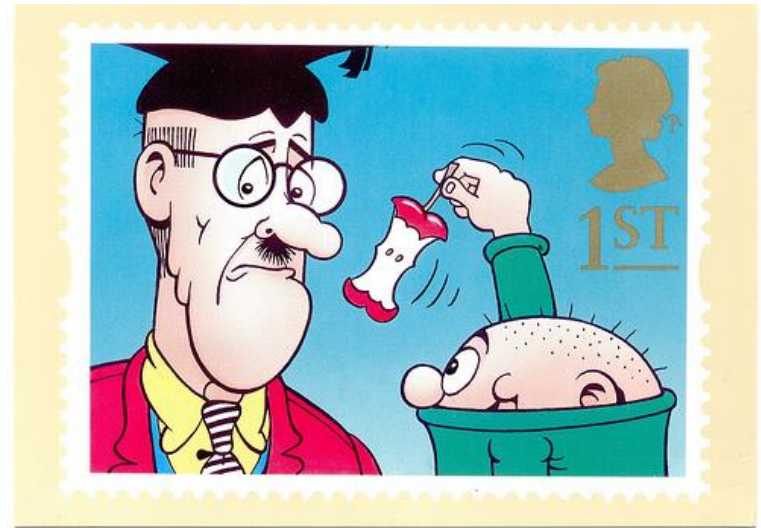

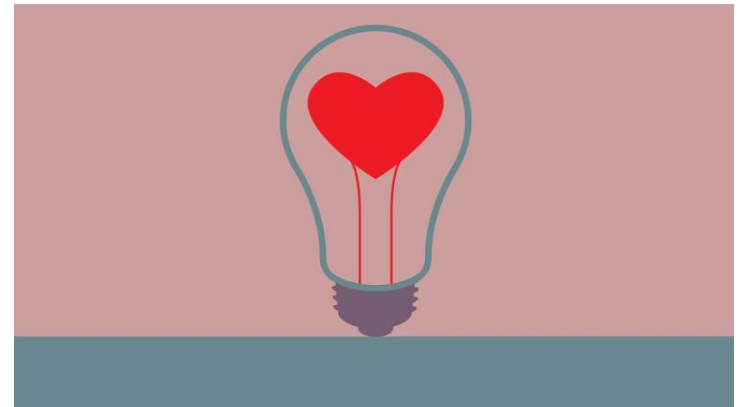

- What are your relevant, transferrable skills and experiences?

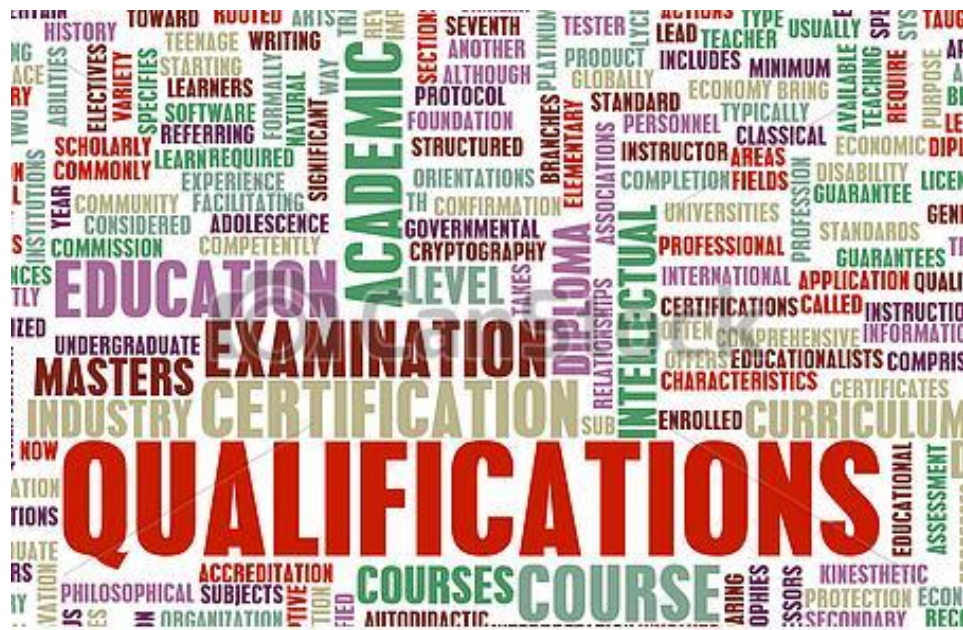


Particular reference to any experience working in or observing lessons in schools
