First aid priorities, managing incidents, causes of unconsciousness, care of an unconscious casualty, basic life support and choking - adult, child and baby, AED, asthma - including the use of inhalers, anaphylaxis - including administering auto-injectors, control of bleeding, burns and scalds, fractures, dislocations, sprains and strains, shock, first aid kits, rules and regulations
