

This course aims to prepare schools for the **statutory changes** coming into force in September 2021

Engagement Model

In order to help schools prepare for this change, the Saffron Alliance Teaching School is offering this new course, led by Department for Education trained & accredited specialists. The one-day course will enable teachers and SENCos to explore the implications of the new assessment model.

It will cover:

- What the Engagement Model is and who is it for?
- How the Engagement Model can be implemented i.e. how it links to the curriculum and the SEND Code of Practice
- Reporting arrangements and accountability within schools

The day is designed for Teachers, SENCo's and Senior Leaders from a school to attend together. As these colleagues will then be able to cascade this training back in their schools.
